Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

The Wayne County Community College District (hereinafter referred to as the “Employer”) and the Wayne County Community College Federation of Teachers, AFT Local 2000 (hereinafter referred to as the “Union”) agree as follows:

1. On November 17, 2005, the Employer and the Union executed a Memorandum of Understanding stating that the Employer, in the exercise of its discretion under the terms of Article XVIII (H)(2) of the AFT Master Agreement, approved a limit of up to a maximum of twenty-four (24) contact hours for full-time (but not probationary or temporary full-time) faculty members for the spring, 2006 and fall, 2006 semesters only.
2. The November 17, 2005 Memorandum of Understanding, which is attached and incorporated by reference, expires after the fall, 2006 semester and contains other conditions governing the approval of the twenty-four (24) contact hour limit.
3. The parties desire to extend the Memorandum of Understanding for an additional semester.
4. Accordingly, the attached November 17, 2005 Memorandum of Understanding is extended to the spring, 2007 semester on the exact terms it contains and will expire after the spring, 2007 semester.
5. Neither this Memorandum nor the November 17, 2005 Memorandum of Understanding create any rights beyond the end of the spring, 2007 semester.
